**6. Announcements, Updates: Chairman or Executive Secretary**

**Executive Secretary:** COGNA conference will be in Golden, CO in August and Executive Secretary will be attending. The Federal Advisory Committee on Reconciliation in Place Names was decommissioned in February, 2025 by the Trump Administration. Legislation is being written to remove the Federal members from the NSBGN in line with Federal request and with general state process. The legislation will also assign the previous seat on the NSBGN to the larger division of the Department of Museums & History and will be assigned by the Administrator.

**7. Whittell Peak (For possible action)**

Discussion surrounding Whittell Peak, proponent reintroduced and board discussed. Motion made by Dominique Etchegoyhen, seconded by Cynthia Laframboise. Votes in favor: ITCN, DCNCR, NDOT, NHS, DNAA, UNR, UNLV, BLM, NSLA, NBMG. Votes opposed: none. Abstentions: none. Motion carried.

**8. Fool's Fount – Elko County (For possible action)**

This application is the first hearing for this site, and came to us from the US Board on Geographic Names. Was sent to BLM for comment already, but Don Harper has retired. This is a perennial spring in the Adobe mountain range of Elko County located on the southern face of tower mountain in the long Canyon. The spring was historically limited to those on horseback or on or on hoof OK however a BLM fire break was created during the coal fire of 2017 that could allow for some motorized access a small pond retains some of the spring flow with the overflow continuing down the natural draw into the long Canyon drainage. Proponent says there is colloquial use among ranchers and sheepherders. No local opposition per proponent. Cliff Banuelos offered to reach out to for more information from Tribal authorities. This site is on land administered by public lands administered by the BLM. Motion made to send to a second hearing made by Paul White, seconded by Dominique Etchegoyhen. Votes in favor: ITCN, DCNCR, NDOT, NHS, DNAA, UNR, UNLV, BLM, NSLA, NBMG. Votes opposed: none. Abstentions: none. Motion carried.
